THINGS TO KNOW

- The Cougars Campgrounds opens at Noon; however, the stadium is not open to the public until 4:00 PM. Re-entry will be allowed for those campers who would like to set up their campsite early.
- If you chose to enter the campsite at 4:00 PM, campers will drop off their gear at Gate 6, using the vehicle turn-a-round, as used in years past.
